- > Collegiality with fellow IACUC members
- > Engaged outside members
- Training-what type?
- > Inadequate administrative support for the IACUC
- IACUC member involvement in program & facility evaluations and inspections

#### **More Discussion Topics**

- > Attending veterinarian engagement in PI and animal care decisions
- Communication of clinical problems to attending veterinarian
- > Degree of IACUC deliberation on sensitive issues
- > Attending veterinarian not engaged in PI animal care decisions
- > Member engagement in protocol reviews or discussions

#### **More Discussion Topics**

- Ethical cost/benefit discussions
- Representatives from major animal use departments
- Challenging comments from other members
- Appreciation of IACUC members by IO and administration
- Prompt reporting of issues as required
- Critical review of protocols and capture of critical issues
